- DATES:** 18, 19 February (Saturday, Sunday), 2023
- LOCATION:** Tri-County Gun Club, Sherwood, Oregon 97132
- SANCTIONED BY:** USA Shooting, 1 Olympic Plaza, Colorado Springs, CO 80909
- ELIGIBILITY:** Each match is open to all competitors 20 years old and younger on the day of the match. All competitors must also be individual members of USA Shooting.

- ENTRY FEES:** \$25.00 per competitor, per discipline. Make checks payable to **TCGC**.
- CATEGORIES:** Junior categories are U21, U18, and U15 and are based off a junior's age on the first day of competition. The following categories will be used:
- Junior (U21); ages 18-20
 - Intermediate Junior (U18); ages 15-17
 - Sub-Junior (U15); ages 14 & under
- CLASSIFICATION:** Shooters will be classified according to their USA Shooting junior category. Entry forms will ask for birth date and expected high school graduation year.
- RULES:** **THE CURRENT ISSF RULES WILL GOVERN**
- COURSE OF FIRE AND TIMING:** Air Rifle: 15 minutes preparation/sighting period followed by 1 hour and 15 minutes for 60 record shots (integer).
Smallbore: 15 minutes preparation/sighting period followed by 1 hour and 45 minutes for 60 total record shots (integer). Competitors must fire 20 record shots for each position in order: Kneeling – Prone – Standing. After competitors complete kneeling and prone positions, unlimited Sighting shots for the next position are allowed. Standard ISSF Rifle Rules 7.7.1, 7.7.3 (*Rifle Events*) apply.

At the completion of each relay, competitors will be afforded 5 minutes to remove their equipment and to evacuate the line. There will be a 15 minute set-up period for the incoming relay. This time will also be used for the range staff to re-set the range.

- DISTANCE:** Air Rifle: 10 m
Smallbore: 50 ft
- TARGETS:** Megalink Electronic Scoring System targets:
Air Rifle: no. 1037, Smallbore: no. 1295
- COACHING:** Verbal coaching will **not** be permitted on the firing line. Non-verbal is permitted.
- SCORING AND PROTESTS:** Scoring is inherent with the Megalink targets. Results will be final 15 minutes after the completion of each respective relay. Ties will be broken in accordance with ISSF rules. Juries will be appointed and convened to resolve any protest. Decisions of the jury will be final. Live scoring will be available at <http://results.megalink.no> via the Tri-County Gun Club link.
- ENTRY AND SCORE SUBMISSION:** Intent to participate in the event is requested via the program Entry Contact. Entries will be made using the official USA Shooting Junior Olympic Shooting Championships Entry Form. Blank entry forms will be provided by the sponsoring organization at the competition each day. Competitors should complete, sign, and date the form prior to leaving the range each day of competition. Entries and scores will be submitted by the Match Director to USA Shooting.
- Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will count for invitation to the National Junior Olympic Championships. Shooters ***may not*** compete in more than one state JOSC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSC, and those who cannot attend their own state JOSC, will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state at entry and are not eligible for state resident awards.
- ENTRIES CLOSE:** Every effort will be made to accept all competitors who enter. To ensure range capacity, contact the Entry Contact at the top of this program no later than 6 February, 2023 to secure placement in the desired events.

Relay 2 – 1100 occupy line; 1115-1130 Prep/Sighting; 1130-1245 Record Fire
- Sunday** (Smallbore – 3P)
Relay 1 – 0845 occupy line; 0900-0915 Prep/Sighting; 0915-1100 Record Fire
Relay 2 – 1130 occupy line; 1145-1200 Prep/Sighting; 1200-1345 Record Fire
- PARTICIPATION** A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be

PINS: given to each competitor.

AWARDS: State Championship medals will be awarded to the top 3 competitors in each discipline: Gold medallion for the top **resident** individual, silver medallion for the 2nd place **resident** individual, and a bronze medallion for the 3rd place **resident** individual.

WAIVER AND JUNIOR RELEASE FORM: All competitors are required to sign a waiver of liability (ages 18 and older) or a completed Junior Release Form (ages 17 and younger) upon entry to the Tri-County Gun Club indoor range. - Head south on I-5 S
- Take exit 286 to merge onto OR-141/SW Boones Ferry Rd (0.3 mi)
- Merge onto OR-141/SW Boones Ferry Rd (0.3 mi)
- Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto SW Day Rd (0.6 mi)
- Turn right onto SW Grahams Ferry Rd (0.4 mi)
- Turn left onto Basalt Creek Pkwy (0.7 mi)
- Turn left onto SW Tonquin Rd (1.0 mi)
- Turn right at Tri-County Gun Club (0.3 mi)

From I-5 S

- Head north on I-5 N
- Take exit 286 toward Stafford/N Wilsonville (0.3 mi)
- Use the left lane to keep left at the fork and follow signs for Boones Ferry Rd (108 ft)
- Turn left onto SW Elligsen Rd (0.2 mi)
- Continue onto OR-141/SW Boones Ferry Rd (0.3 mi)
- Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto SW Day Rd (0.6 mi)
- Turn right onto SW Grahams Ferry Rd (0.4 mi)
- Turn left onto Basalt Creek Pkwy (0.7 mi)
- Turn left onto SW Tonquin Rd (1.0 mi)
- Turn right at Tri-County Gun Club (0.3 mi)
